Fisherman Led Injury Prevention Program

The Oregon State University (OSU) Environmental and Occupational Health College of Public Health and Human Sciences received a grant to look at crabbing related injuries and fishermen's insights on safety. The team conducted a survey with crab fishermen up and down the coast. Some of you may have taken the survey.
