

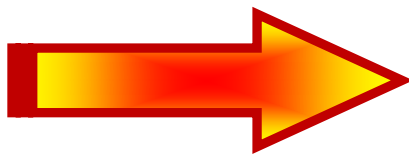

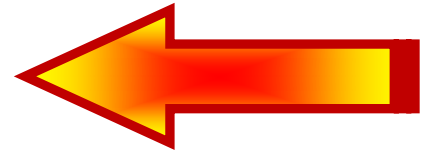

Drill Conductor Course is a 2 day class, 7:45am to 5:00pm. Students will learn emergency procedures and the use of safety equipment aboard commercial fishing vessels. The class will be hands-on, including immersion suit donning, entering the water, then into a life raft, starting pumps, putting out fires, etc. Training is required by 46 CFR 28.270(c). Refresher training is recommended every 5 years.
